

How to Calculate your Basic Residential Water & Wastewater Bill

Water Usage
(from your bill)

24.6 m³

2026

Water and wastewater bills will be issued every other month – January, March, May, July, September & November
Remember that the total amount on your bill is for two months of service and use.
The following is a typical bill calculation without any extra surcharges or adjustments*.

1

Base Rate = \$73.74

*based on 20 mm (5/8") water meter

This is the bimonthly cost for being connected to the municipal water and sewer systems, before usage charges.

\$73.74 **A**

Water Use Charge

Your water meter is read each billing period to determine water usage in cubic metres (1 m³ = 220 gallons)

Water Usage (m³) x \$1.20

=

\$29.52 **B**

3

Sewer Use Charge

Sewer usage is not metered directly. We use water usage for this calculation.

Water Usage (m³) x \$1.56

=

\$38.38 **C**

4

Total Usage Charges (A + B + C)

=

\$141.64 **D**

5

Capital Reserve Fund

These funds are set aside for maintenance and renewal of infrastructure

Total Usage Charges (D) x 0.6666

=

\$94.42 **E**

6

Total Bill (D + E)

=

\$236.06

*Surcharges and adjustments include water termination/restoration fees, property sale/meter reading fees and/or sump pump fees.
